



## Did you know...

**When food is sent to landfill it rots and releases methane, a harmful greenhouse gas with 21 times the global warming potential of carbon dioxide.**

By using the Kitchen Organics Service you can easily stop sending food scraps and other compostable items to landfill. When food and organic items are composted, they can be used again as soil conditioner or fertiliser, to grow plants and food.

Composting is easy, inexpensive and reduces the amount of waste sent to landfill. 59.4% of waste found in the general waste/landfill bin (red lid) could be composted or recycled. Don't waste your rates.

**\$423,000** could be saved every year

*if all food and compostable materials were placed in the organics bin (green lid) instead of in the general waste/landfill bin (red lid).*

# Did you know, in the City of Norwood Payneham & St Peters you can compost food with the green bin collection?

Through the Kitchen Organics Service, every household is entitled to one free kitchen caddy and 150 compostable bags. A new supply of compostable bags can be collected every 12 months.

## Composting food is easy

- 1 Receive your free kitchen caddy and compostable bags from the Council.
- 2 Place a certified compostable bag into the caddy, or line it with newspaper.
- 3 Fill it up with leftover food and organic scraps, including egg shells, tea bags, peel and coffee granules.
- 4 After 2–3 days, or once full, tie the bag and place into your green bin ready for fortnightly collection.

\*only certified compostable bags can be placed in the green bin to be composted. These will start breaking down every few days, so make sure you empty the caddy regularly.

## What can be composted?

Anything that once grew can be composted through the Kitchen Organics Service, whether its whole or scraps, cooked or raw, including:

Fruit and vegetables  
Dairy products  
Meat and bones  
Cake, pasta and bread  
Egg shells, seafood and oyster shells  
Paper towels, napkins and tissues  
Corn cobs  
Coffee grounds  
Tea bags (including tags)  
Hair  
Cut flowers

## Please do not put these items in the caddy

- ✗ Plastic bags (including bio-degradable)
- ✗ Cling wrap or foil
- ✗ Cigarette butts and ash
- ✗ Dishcloths and sponges

\*proof of residency will be required to receive your free caddy.

## How to get your free compostable bags

The Council provides each household with 150 compostable bags to line the kitchen caddy. This is approximately one year's supply. You can collect your compostable bags from Norwood Town Hall or any of the Council's libraries (proof of residency will be required).

If you run out of compostable bags before your next annual allocation, you can purchase them from Norwood Town Hall or any of the Council's libraries for \$4.60 per 75 bag roll.

If you purchase compostable bags from another retailer, look for the Australian Standard AS4736 logo to make sure they're 100% compostable. Bags that are not compostable cannot be used in the kitchen caddy.
